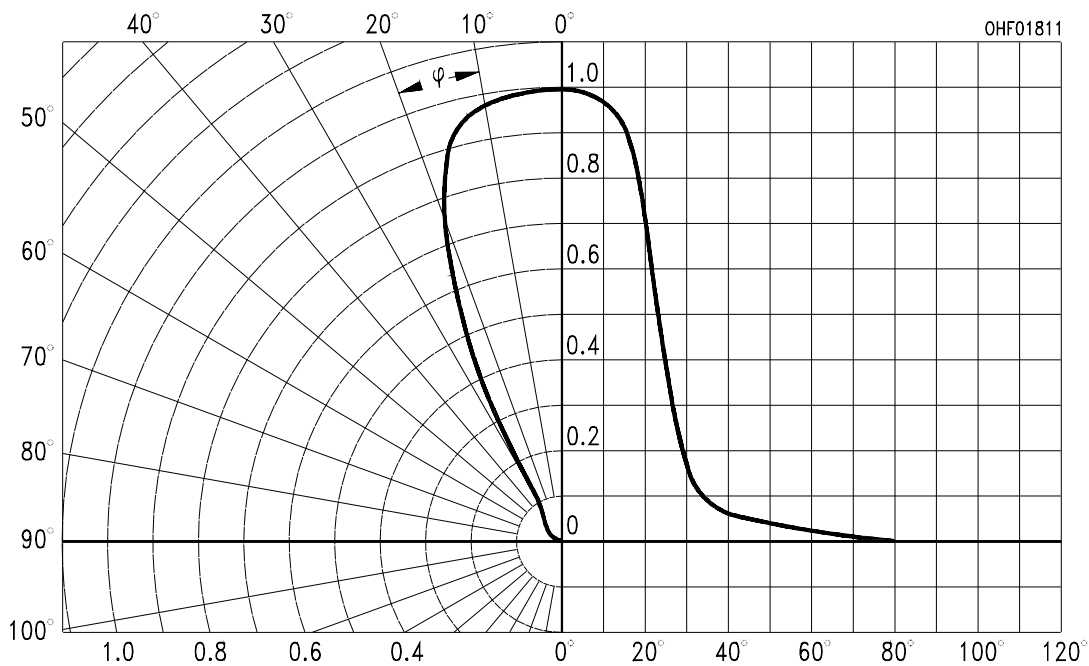

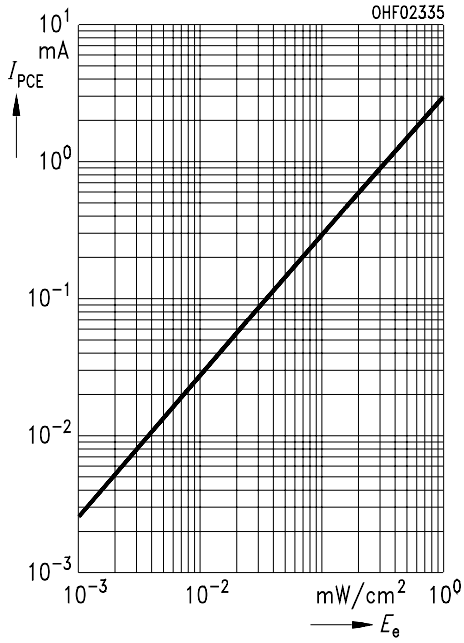

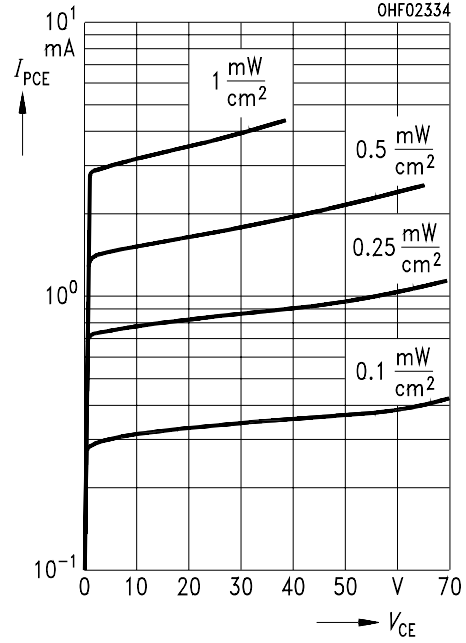

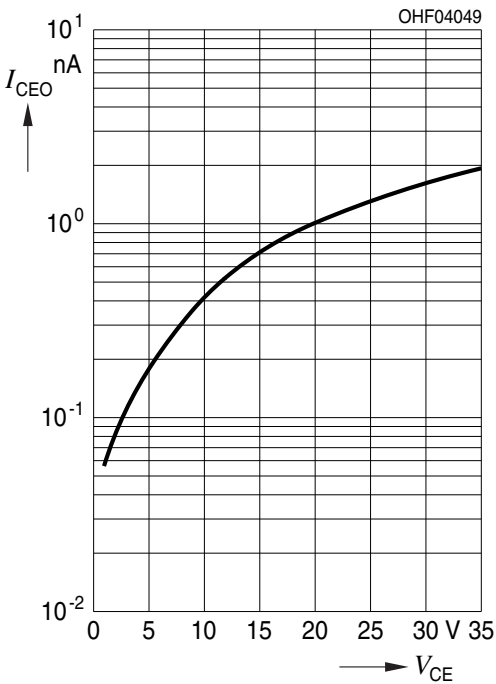

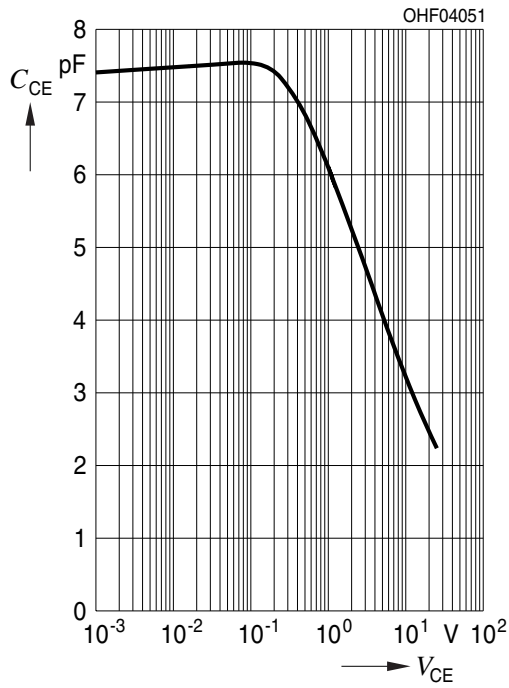

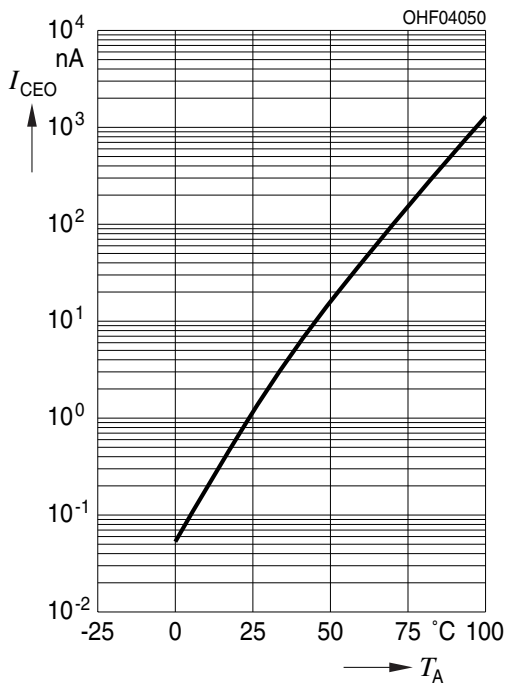

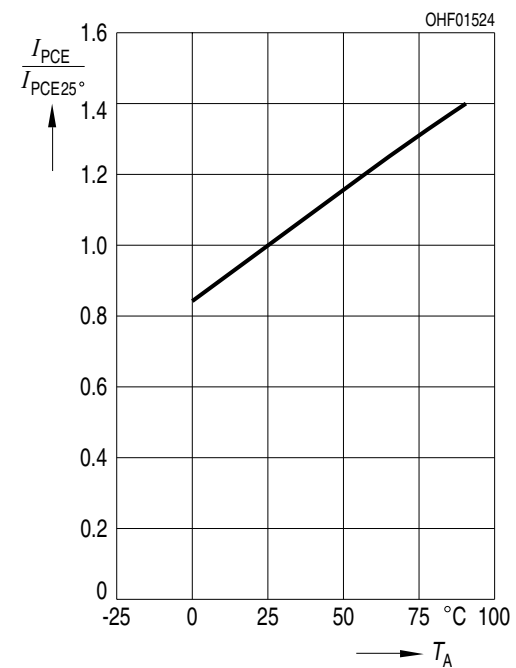

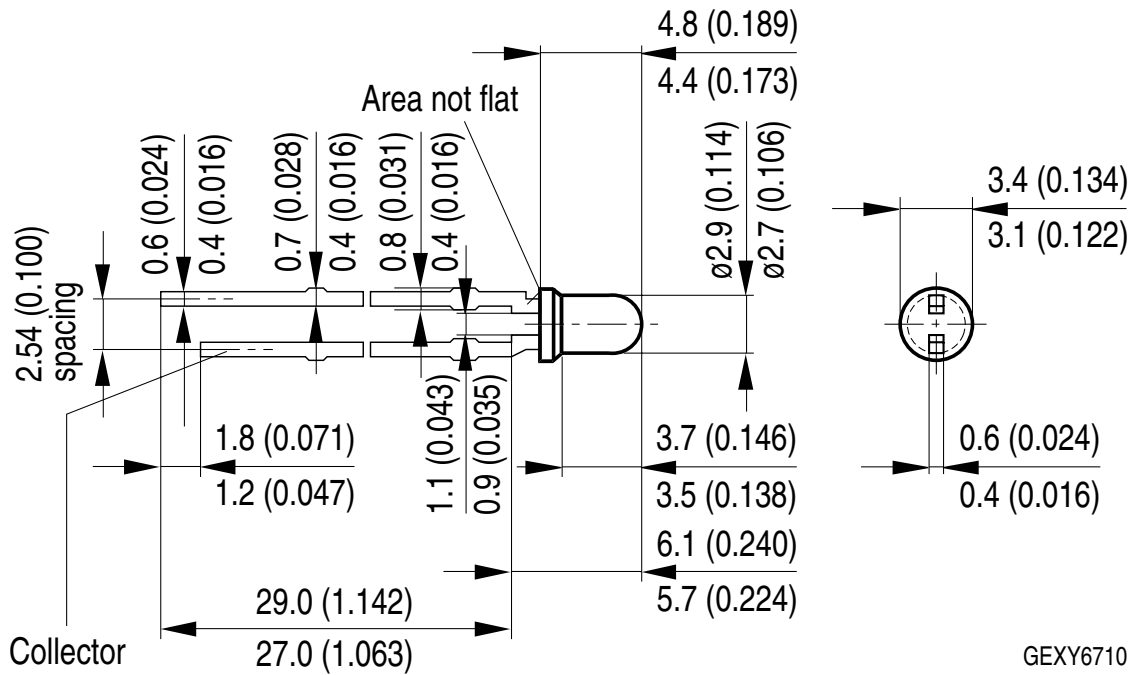

Dimensional Drawing <sup>6)</sup>



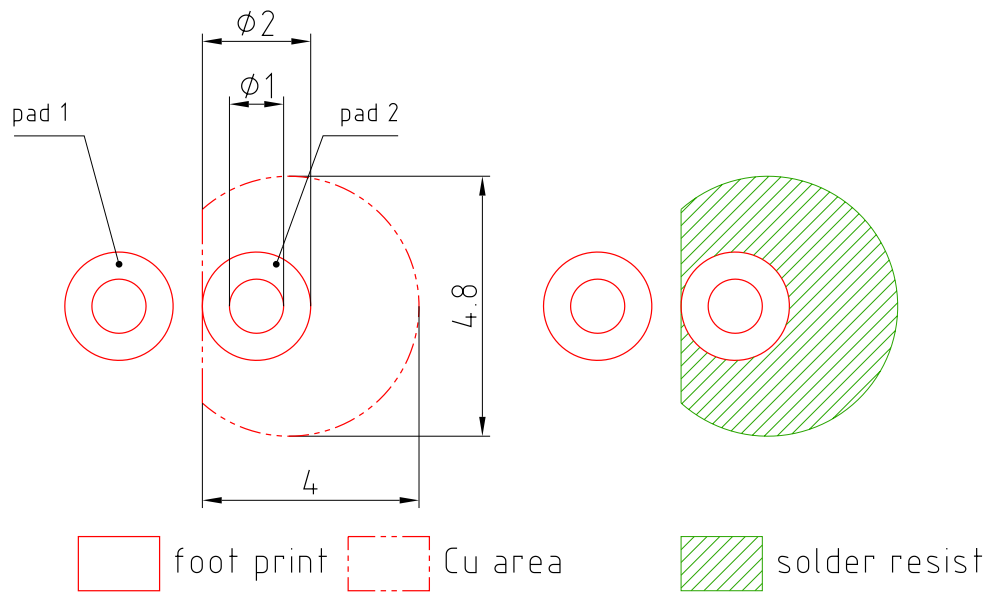
