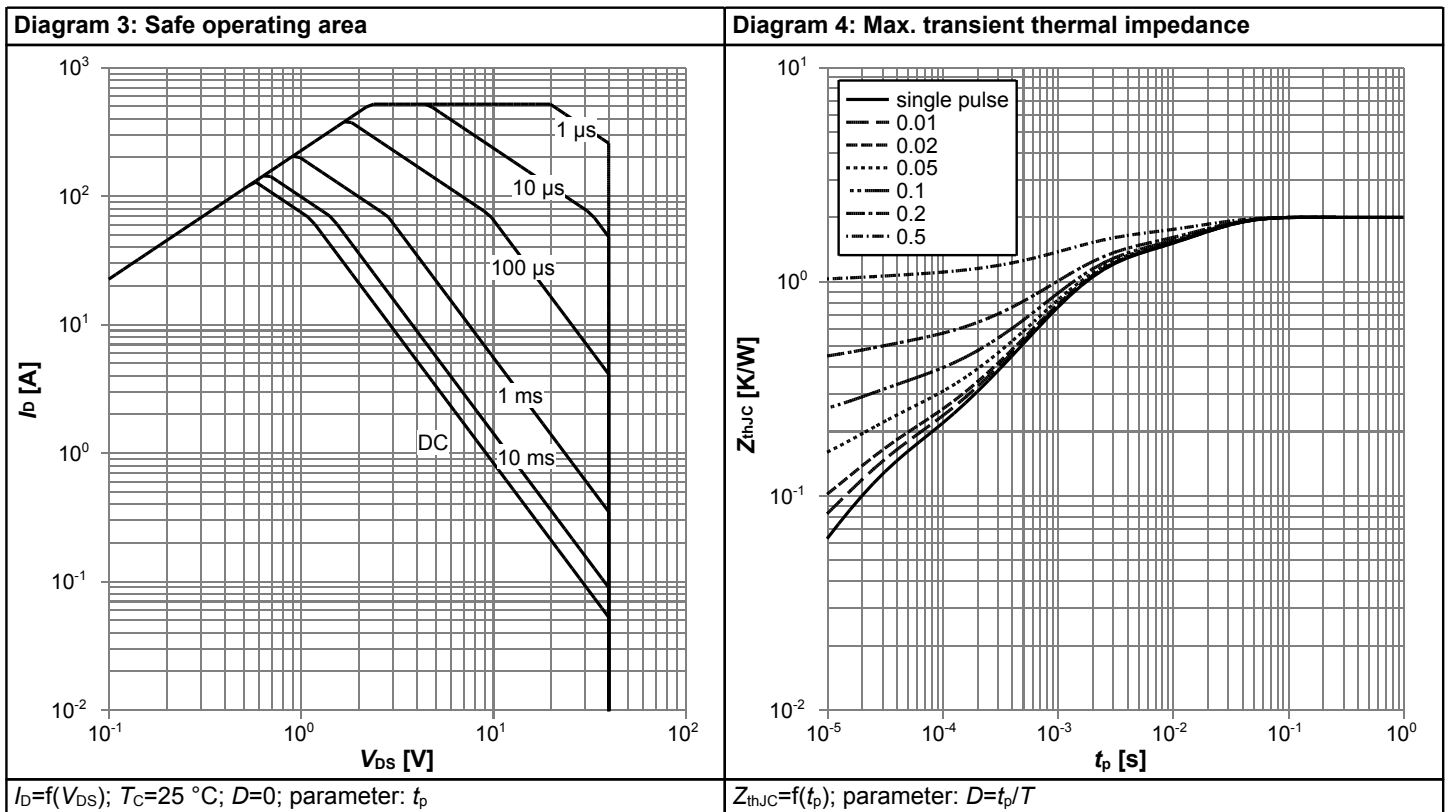
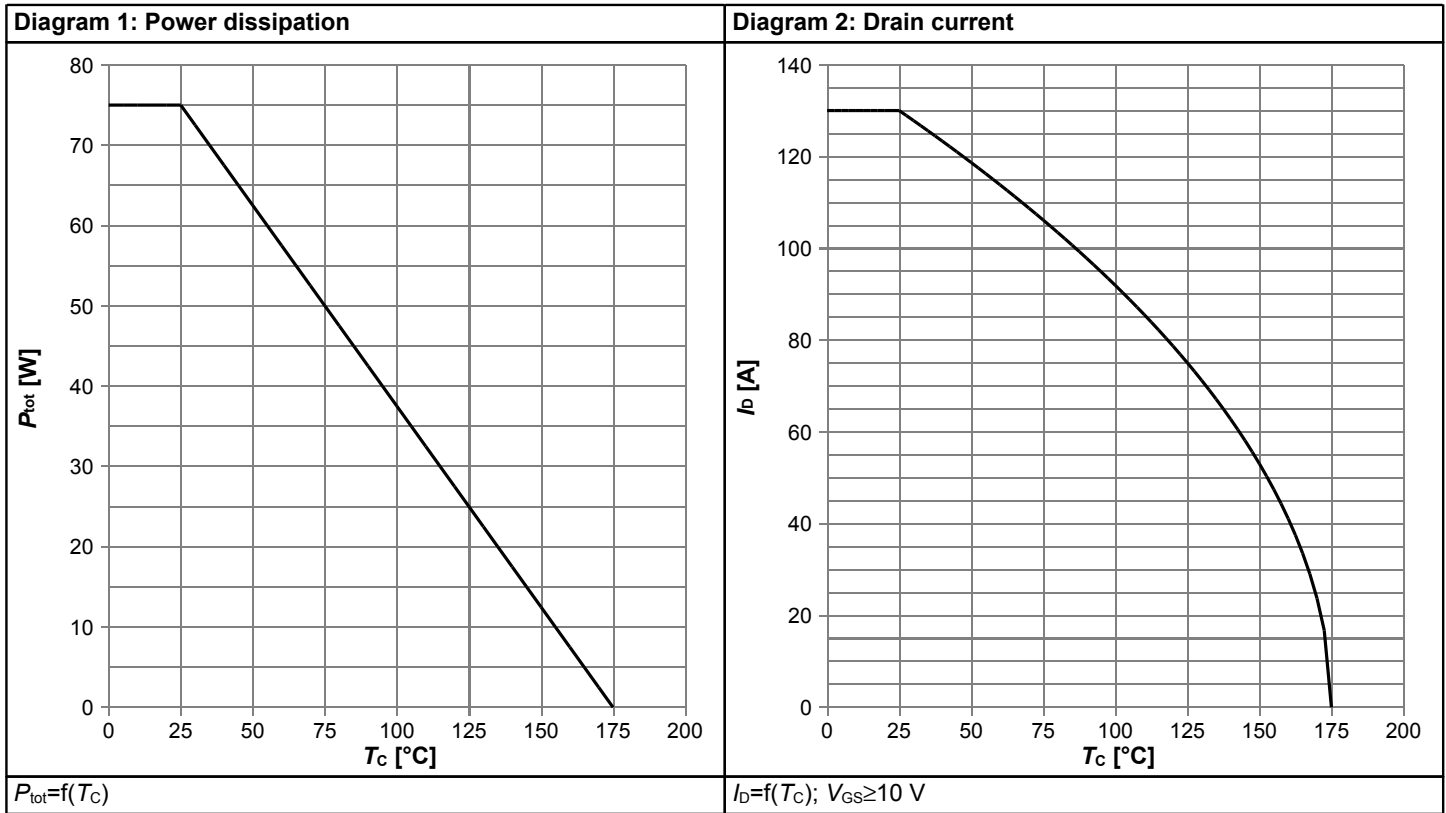
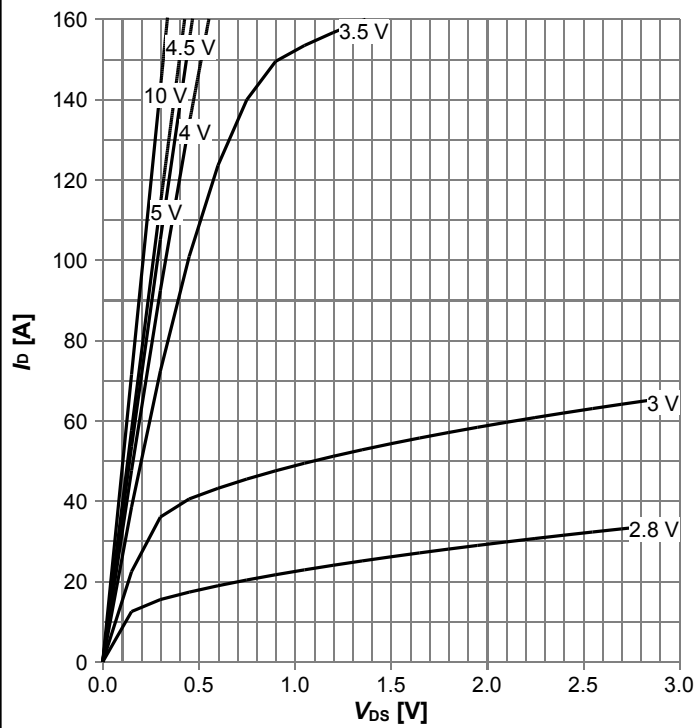
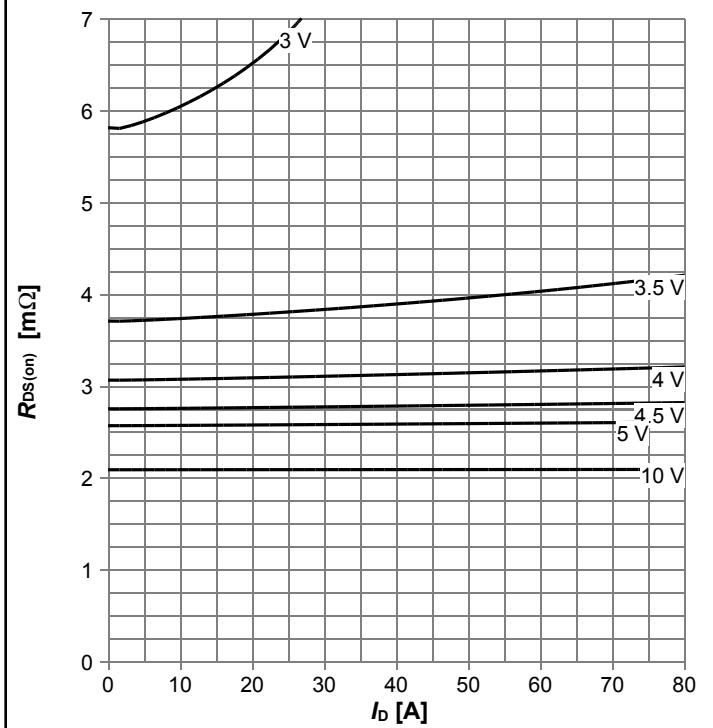


Diagram 5: Typ. output characteristics



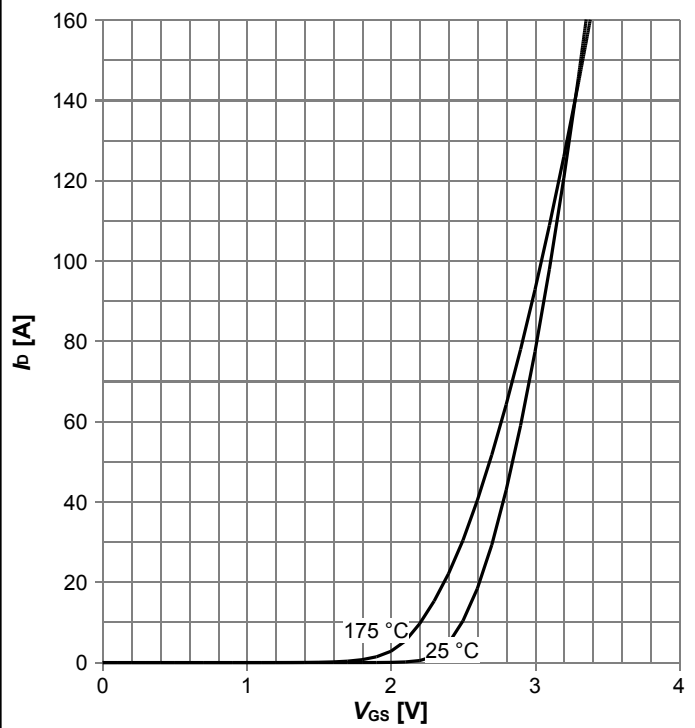
$I_D = f(V_{DS})$ ,  $T_j = 25^\circ\text{C}$ ; parameter:  $V_{GS}$

Diagram 6: Typ. drain-source on resistance



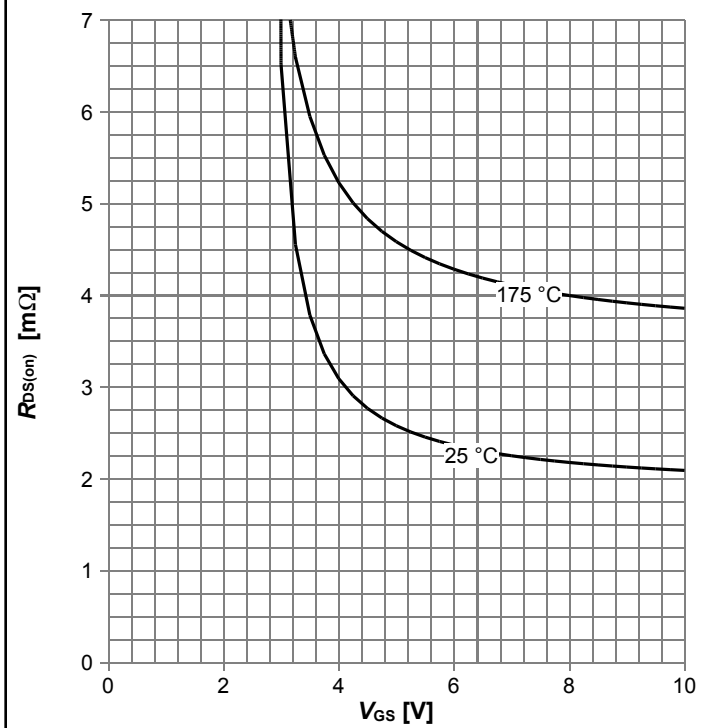
$R_{DS(on)} = f(I_D)$ ,  $T_j = 25^\circ\text{C}$ ; parameter:  $V_{GS}$

Diagram 7: Typ. transfer characteristics



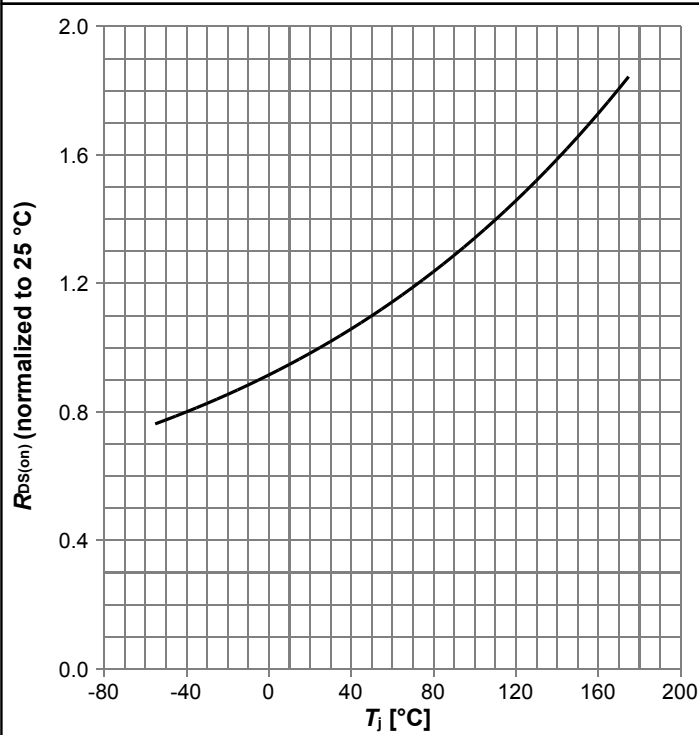
$I_D = f(V_{GS})$ ,  $|V_{DS}| > 2|I_D|R_{DS(on)max}$ ; parameter:  $T_j$

Diagram 8: Typ. drain-source on resistance



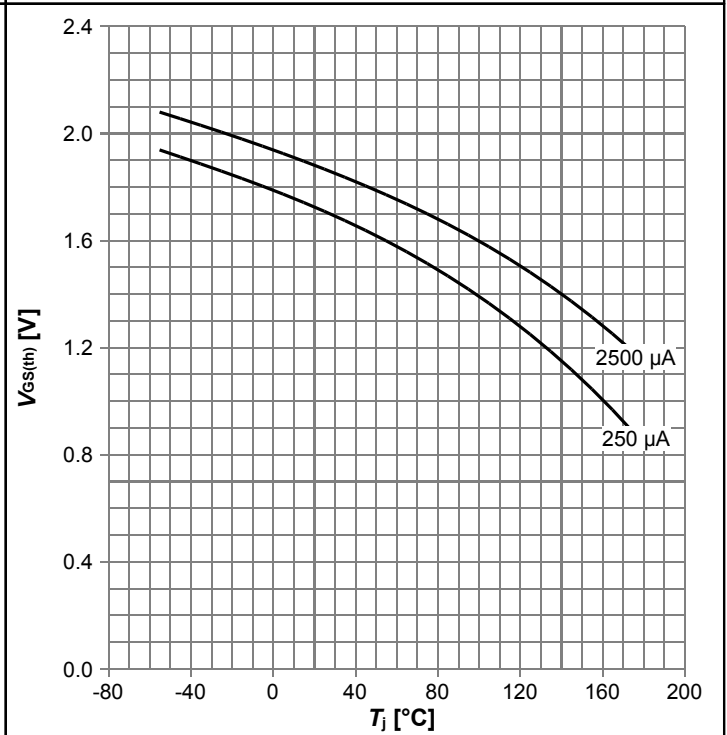

Diagram 9: Normalized drain-source on resistance



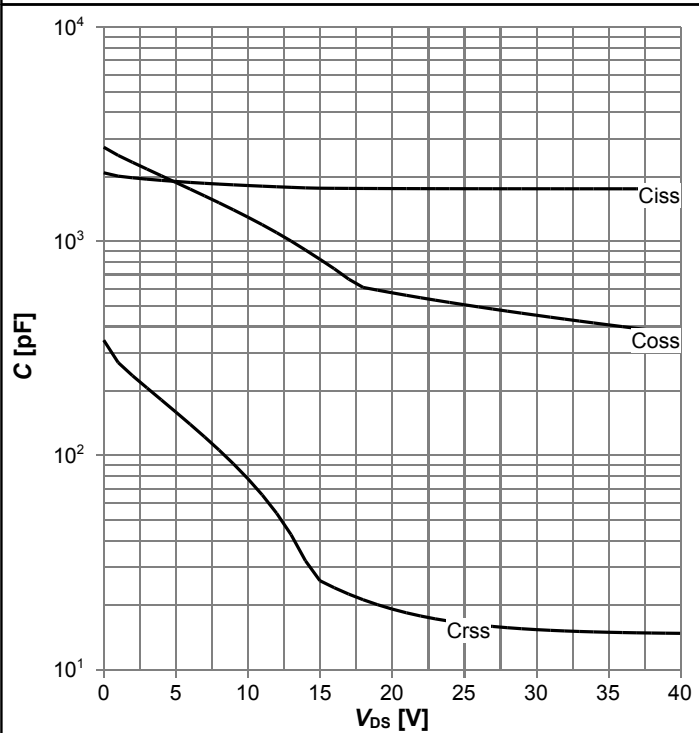

Diagram 10: Typ. gate threshold voltage



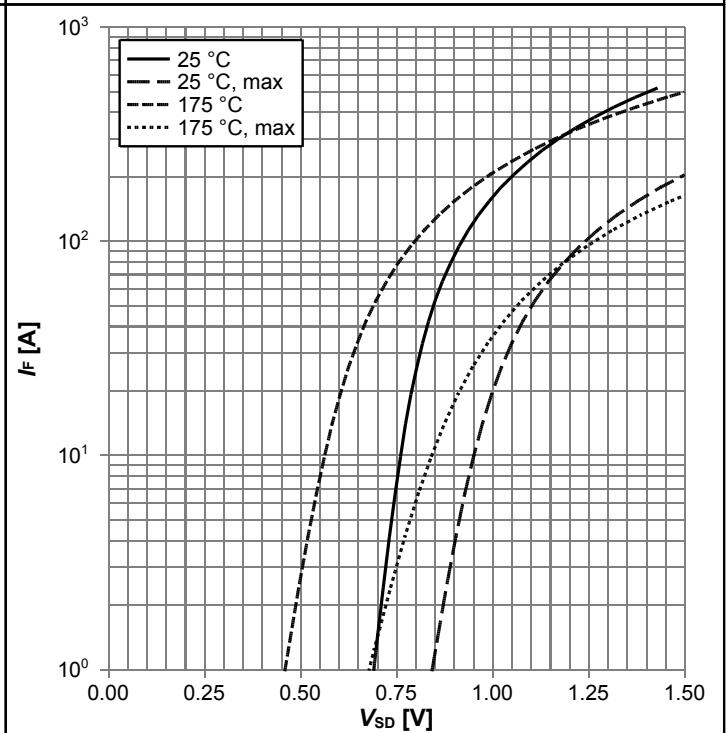

Diagram 11: Typ. capacitances



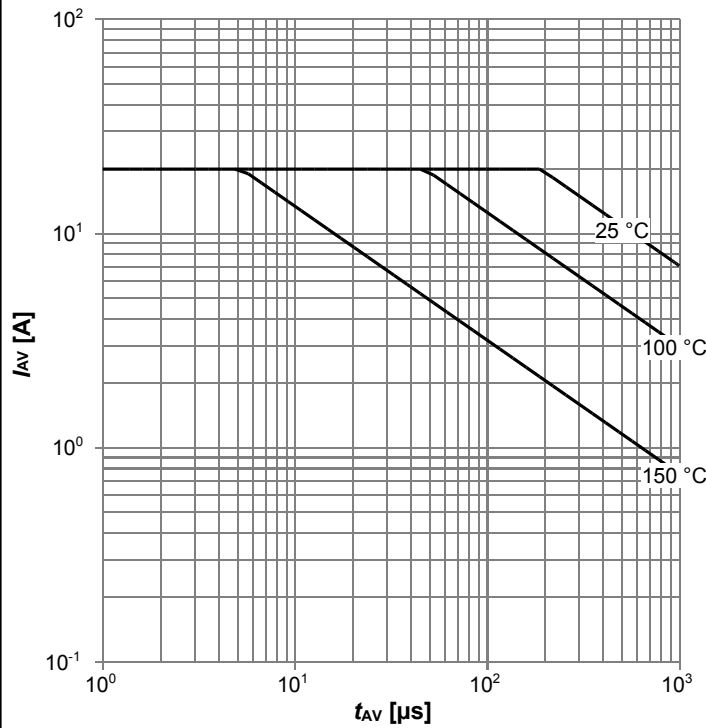

Diagram 12: Forward characteristics of reverse diode



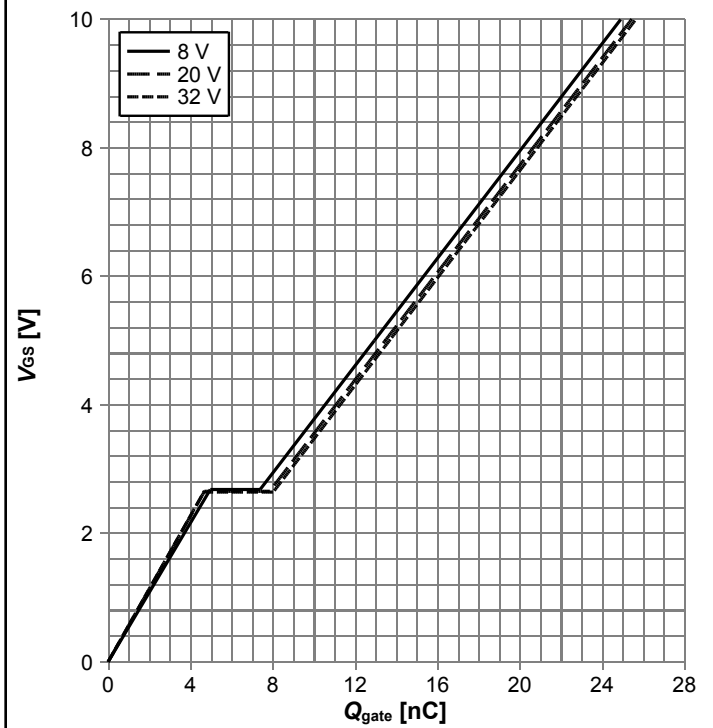

**Diagram 13: Avalanche characteristics**



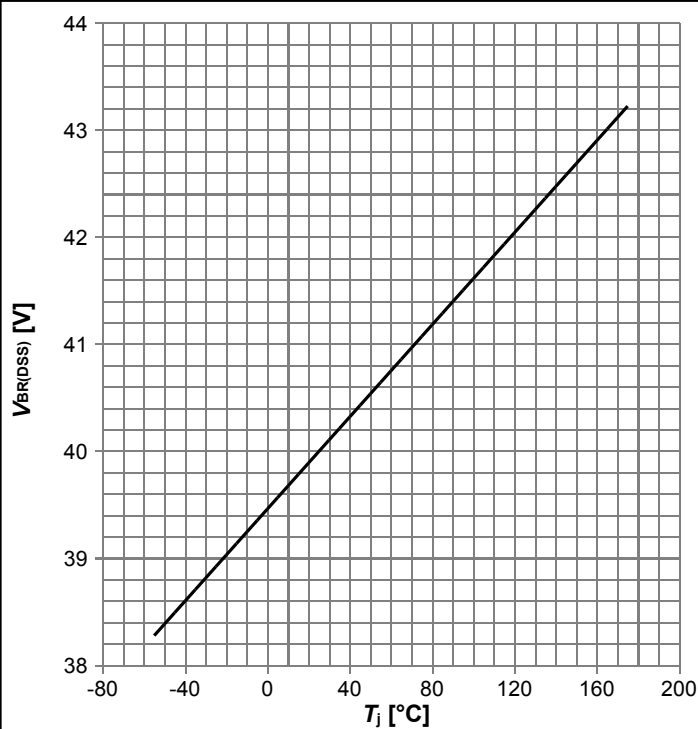

**Diagram 15: Drain-source breakdown voltage**

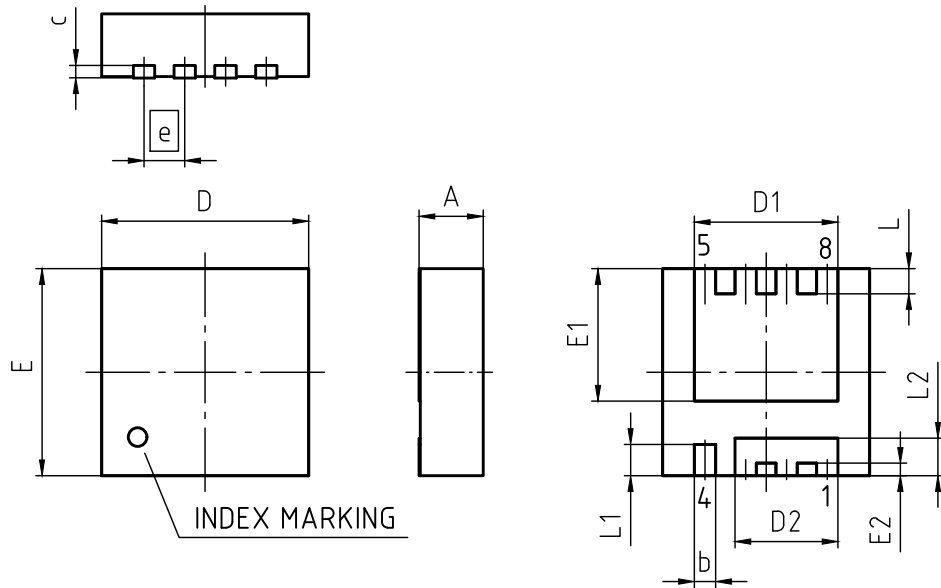


$V_{BR(DSS)}=f(T_j); I_D=1 \text{ mA}$
