



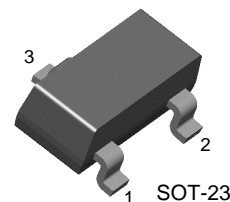

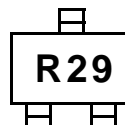

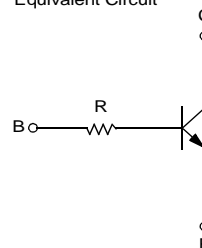


1. Base 2. Emitter 3. Collector

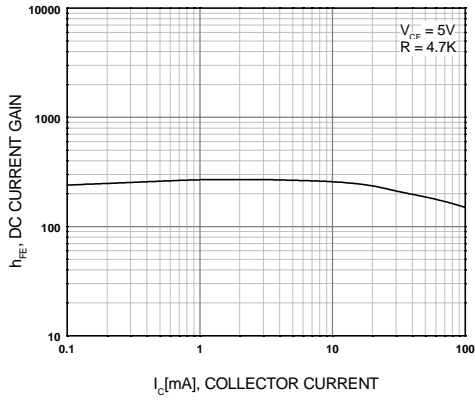


Figure 1. DC current Gain

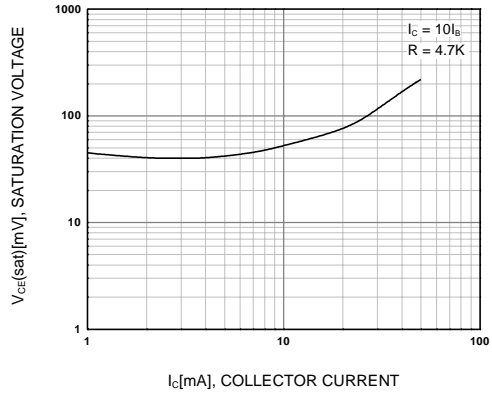


Figure 2. Collector-Emitter Saturation Voltage

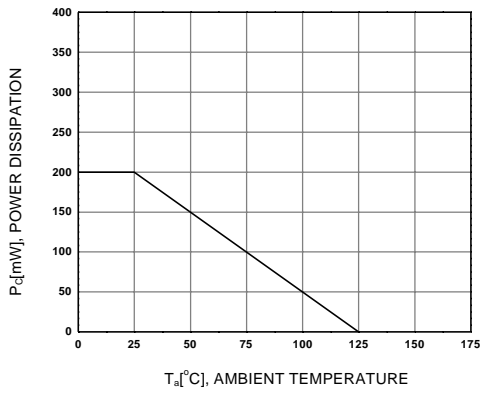
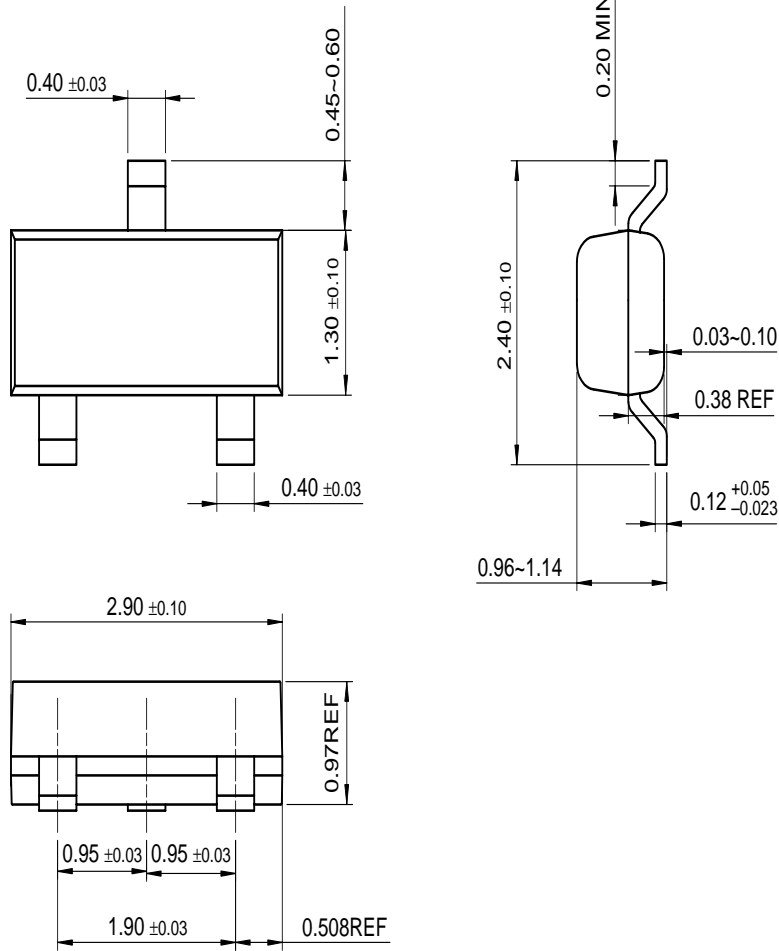


Figure 3. Power Derating
